Getting Spicy With Salsa

Celebrating Cinco de Mayo this month means many people will be serving up some salsa. Take your taste buds on a spin and get ready to dip into these different salsa varieties.

Salsa roja. The classic red salsa is made with tomatoes, chili peppers, onions, garlic and cilantro. Blended and cooked, this salsa is perfect for dipping chips or topping enchiladas.

Salsa verde. The tomatillo is the star of salsa verde, often lending the green condiment a slightly tarter flavor than its red counterpart. Salsa verde goes great with grilled meats.

Pico de gallo. Also known as salsa fresca, pico de gallo is fresh salsa that is served uncooked. Chopped tomatoes, jalapenos, onions, cilantro and lime make salsa fresca the ultimate versatile topping for many dishes. For a fancy twist, other fresh ingredients can be substituted for tomatoes, such as cucumber or pineapple to create a different flavor combination.

The History of Memorial Day

Observed with ceremonies and parades, Memorial Day honors the men and women who gave their lives while serving in the U.S. military.

After the Civil War ended in 1865, people in various cities began decorating the graves of fallen soldiers with flowers, flags and wreaths. This inspired Maj. Gen. John A. Logan, the head of a veterans organization, to designate May 30, 1868, as Decoration Day, a national day of remembrance. It's believed that date was chosen because it didn't fall on the anniversary of any battle, and flowers would be in bloom all over the country.

On that first Decoration Day, a large ceremony was held at Arlington National Cemetery in Washington, D.C. Officials gave speeches, and more than 5,000 people placed small American flags on the graves of 20,000 Civil War soldiers.

After World War I, Decoration Day was expanded to honor fallen soldiers from all wars. An act of Congress officially renamed it Memorial Day in 1967, and when the law went into effect in 1971, the date of observation was changed to the last Monday in May.

Gardens Around the Globe

With blooming flowers and budding trees, a garden in springtime is an inviting place to enjoy nature's splendor.

Keukenhof. Called the "garden of Europe," this park in the town of Lisse in the western Netherlands is famous for its brilliant display of Dutch tulips, along with daffodils, crocuses, hyacinths and bluebells. More than 7 million bulbs are planted each year to bloom from March through May.

Gardens of Versailles. Commissioned by King Louis XIV in 1661, this formal French garden outside of Paris covers 2,000 acres on the grounds at the Palace of Versailles. Visitors can walk along topiary-lined pathways or ride a boat on the Grand Canal to view thousands of trees and plants and hundreds of statues and fountains.

Villa d'Este. The enchanted terraced gardens of this Renaissance-style estate in Tivoli, Italy, date back to the 16th century and are known for their elaborate water features, including waterfalls, fish ponds and over 50 fountains.

All About Artichokes

Resembling large, green flowers with pointed petals, artichokes are one of the more unique offerings in the produce department.

Artichokes are members of the thistle family, and the part we eat is actually the plant's flower bud. They are one of the world's oldest cultivated foods, dating back to ancient Greece and Rome. French immigrants brought artichokes to America in the early 1800s, and Presidents George Washington and Thomas Jefferson grew the vegetable.

Spring is peak season for fresh artichokes, which can be baked, boiled, steamed or grilled. The individual petals are usually pulled off and dipped in melted butter and other sauces. The meaty core, called the heart, is considered a delicacy and often served as an ingredient in dips and salads.

The green globes are low-calorie, fat-free and loaded with nutrients. One artichoke contains 10 grams of fiber about one-third of the recommended daily amount and is a rich source of antioxidants, including vitamin C, folate and magnesium.

How to Wash a Swimsuit

Keep a swimsuit in great shape all summer long-and for summers to come—by properly washing it every time it's worn. First, soak the suit in cool water for 15 to 30 minutes. Then hand-wash the suit in a sink of cool water with 1 teaspoon of laundry detergent. Gently squeeze water out of the suit and roll it in a towel to remove excess water. Lay flat to dry. If you must wash the swimsuit in a machine, turn the suit inside out and use cold water and the delicate cycle.
